INTERNATIONAL students from around the world who are in Noosa learning English also get a taste of indigenous culture, with workshops about the didgeridoo.

Noosa-based team development group Bushlab held a workshop

with Global Village language students last week, showing how to play the instrument and teaching about indigenous culture and history.

Scott Estrich from Bushlab said the students were from countries

including Korea, Japan, Germany, France, Switzerland, Russia and Brazil.

"These students take back to their homeland a lot more than just a greater knowledge of English. They take some personal

history about Australia's indigenous culture and music," he said.

Scott held a workshop at Peregian College last week and will hold another in Pinnaroo Park, Noosa Junction, today, August 5, at 2pm.
